1 Peter 5:1 ESV - 1 So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed:



















1 Peter 5:4 ESV - 4 And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.



Younger Men are to Submit Humbly to the Community's Elders (5:5-6)

1 Peter 5:5 ESV - 5 Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."



1 Peter 5:7-10 ESV - 7 casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you. 8 Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. 9 Resist him, firm in your faith,



1 Peter 5:7-10 ESV - knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. 10 And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.



What are Peter's two solutions to suffering?

- 1. Cast your anxiety upon God (v. 7).
- 2. It is in heaven Jesus will restore us (v. 10).



Melanchthon in Augsburg Confession: "The person who knows that he has a Father who is gracious to him truly knows God.")



IV. Final Greetings (5:12-14)

1 Peter 5:12-14 ESV - 12 By Silvanus, a faithful brother as I regard him, I have written briefly to you, exhorting and declaring that this is the true grace of God. Stand firm in it. 13 She who is at Babylon, who is likewise chosen, sends you greetings, and so does Mark, my son. 14 Greet one another with the kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.
