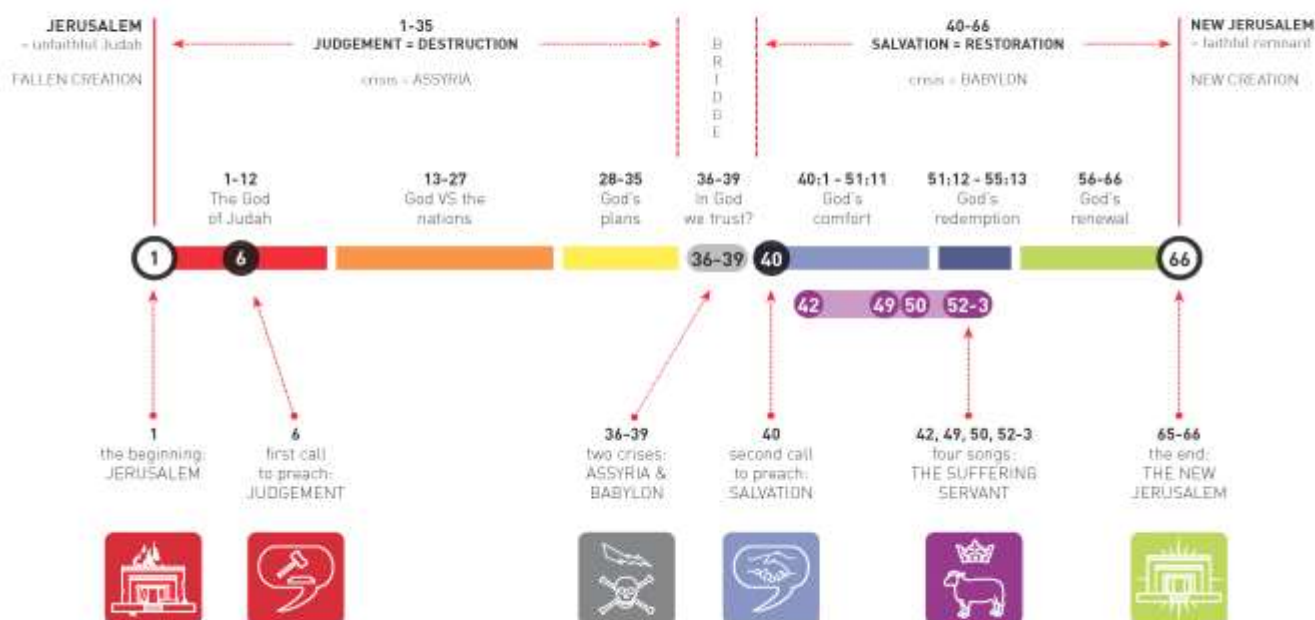

Unity of language (Holy one of Israel 24 times—Is 5:24 and Is 10:20) and thought, tradition, Bible quotes as a unity John 12:38-41
